

5TH WHEEL UNHITCHING

CHECKLIST FOR WILD THING

<input type="checkbox"/>	Park the Trailer then Check the Level of the Trailer Side to Side
<input type="checkbox"/>	Use Anderson Leveling Blocks (or similar) as needed to Level the Trailer Laterally (Side to Side)
<input type="checkbox"/>	Install X-Chocks and Lock with a Padlock
<input type="checkbox"/>	Chock both Wheels with Front and Back Chocks
<input type="checkbox"/>	Lower Truck Tailgate
<input type="checkbox"/>	Disconnect the 7 Pin Connection
<input type="checkbox"/>	Lower Landing Gear to Blocks until the Weight of the Trailer is off the Hitch & On the Landing Gear
<input type="checkbox"/>	Observe the Truck Bed Angle and Envision how it will move away from the Trailer,
<input type="checkbox"/>	Remove Cotter Pin on Hitch Arm and Remove Break-Away Cable
<input type="checkbox"/>	Move Hitch Arm to Open Position and Pin in Open Position with Cotter Pin
<input type="checkbox"/>	Slowly Pull Truck Forward watching to be sure the Weight Stays On the Landing Gear, Not the Hitch
<input type="checkbox"/>	Adjust Height of Trailer Nose if Truck Bed is Angling Upward when Pulling Away. Where's the Weight?
<input type="checkbox"/>	Once the trailer is Fully Unhitched from the Truck, Level Trailer Front to Back using Landing Gear
<input type="checkbox"/>	Lower Rear Stabilizers
<input type="checkbox"/>	Make desired connections:
<input type="checkbox"/>	Connect Water Hose to City Water. Always Use Water Pressure Regulator
<input type="checkbox"/>	Connect Sewer Hose always using a Sewer Hose Support
<input type="checkbox"/>	Turn OFF ALL the breakers on the Campsite Electrical Power Connection Box
<input type="checkbox"/>	Connect Electrical Cord to the Campsite Electrical Power Connection Box then Turn On the Breaker
<input type="checkbox"/>	Connect TV Cable Connection if applicable
<input type="checkbox"/>	Install the 5 th Wheel King Pin Lock
